## Lighthouse Employee Wins Top Honor

Marilyn Parsons took home the top award at the TIBH Industries banquet and expo.

The Artie Lee Hinds Award is presented to the top individual in the State of Texas that has excelled in their job performance and attitude.

The WorksWonders Program provides job opportunities to people who are blind or have other disabilities in the State of Texas. She was chosen out of 6,000 individuals with disabilities employed through this program.

"What a night to remember, this is just wonderful," said Marilyn. "It's an honor that I will cherish for the rest of my life".

Marilyn began losing her sight in 1979 due to Sarcoidosis (in which granulomas form in various organs). During the 80's her vision progressively worsened which led to numerous surgeries. After that her vision improved for a while, but due to scarring on the retina, she was left with numerous blind spots. The doctor told Marilyn she would have to quit working be-

cause she was a danger to herself as well as others with her vision.

For 22 years Marilyn had worked as an activity director and assistant administrator at a nursing home, and now she found herself without employment. She states that she was an "emotional wreck." She stayed home and completed housework and yard work but mostly thought about what she couldn't do, or what she wouldn't be able to do in the future.
